

Teacher Directions

Print enough Classmate Bingo cards for each student in your class.

Set a timer for five to ten minutes, depending on how long you want to play.

When the timer starts, students should walk around the room searching for classmates who can match the information in each square. Once a match is found, that classmate should initial the square. At the end of the time, any student who has found five in a row can get a prize.

You may want to allow your students to read some of the things they learned about their classmates. You could go around the room and have each student begin with the phrase “I found out ____.” For example, “I found out Tyler has a pet fish.”
